CAUTION: Knockout panel may cause injury if it is dropped during removal from the top panel.

Intended Use

Install only in a restricted service environment, such as a data center. Use indoors only, in environmentally controlled areas; do not use outdoors, in harsh environments or in air-handling spaces.

Tools Required

Straight Blade Screw Driver

Included Parts

4 Brush Assemblies (2 pair)

Assembly Sequence


- 1. Knockout Panel Removal:
 - a. Determine which knockout will be removed from the Top Panel.
 - b. Using a flat bladed screwdriver, insert the blade into the rectangular openings around the edge of the knockout panel. Force the knockout panel upward with a prying action until it breaks loose; DO NOT PRY THE PANEL DOWNWARD AS THIS COULD CAUSE THE PANEL TO FALL OUT. <u>NEVER REMOVE THE PANEL FROM INSIDE OF THE CABINET</u>.
 - c. Repeat step "b" for each screwdriver opening in the following order:
 - i. Do all openings along one side.
 - ii. Do all openings on the opposite side. When the last opening is broken, lift the panel upward and grasp it with your hands.
 - iii. Continue to raise the panel, it will hinge on the edge that is still attached, until it breaks loose.



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- 2. Brush Assembly Installation:
 - a. Position one brush assembly with its guide pins onto one half of the knockout opening using the alignment holes.
 - b. Push brush assembly onto opening until it snaps into place.
 - c. Repeat steps 2a and 2b to cover entire knockout.
- 3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 for second opening if desired.
- 4. To remove brush assembly:
 - a. Disengage the two small snap hooks on opposite ends of brush assembly.
 - b. Disengage the two large snap hooks next to the guide pins.
 - c. Slide the brush assembly off.
 - d. Repeat for other side brush assembly.
