# Motive Vertical Cable Manager


### Intended Use

Install this vertical cable manager (VCM) only in a restricted service environment, such as a data center or telecommunications room. Use indoors only, in environmentally controlled areas; do not use outdoors, in harsh environments or in air-handling spaces. Use this VCM to house copper and fiber data communications cabling. Allow only qualified service personnel to use this VCM.

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
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
### Assembly Sequence

- 1. Lay the center accessory rail on the floor.
- 2. Position one side panel assembly against the ends of the crossbars of the central accessory rail. The side panel should be oriented so that the arrow on the side panel is at the top and the RMU numbering on the central accessory rail starts at the bottom. Fit the crossbar ends into the pockets of the side assembly. Install two M6x30 flat head screws, using provided Torx bit, into each crossbar as shown.
- 3. Repeat step 2 for the other side assembly.




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
- 4. Stand the manager up, the arrows on the side panels should be at the top as shown.
- 5. Install the bottom cross bar(s), (1 for the single sided and 2 for the double sided manager). Position the bar over the side bosses on the side assembly arms and push straight down until it snaps in place.



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- 6. Mounting the cable manager to the rack:
  - a. Position the manager next to the rack. For the double sided manager use the appropriate mounting holes as show below. For 3 inch wide racks the inner holes are used with the manager biased towards the rear. For 6 inch wide racks the outer holes are used.
  - Attach the manager to the rack using 4 each of M8 carriage bolts, washers, and flange nuts. Use the upper and lower pairs of holes, as shown in the picture on the right.
  - c. If the manager is being mounted between two racks, repeat Step b. for the other side.





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### 7. Installing Doors:

- a. Stand the door upright, the front door will have the logo at the top. For double-sided managers, the rear door is a plain flat door (no logo). The two blue latches on the back side of the door should be pointing downward for the correct orientation.
- b. Lift the door with the top angled outward and position the bottom hinges over the pins on the manager arms as shown at right.
- c. Push the top of the door inward until the top hinges engage.



**WARNING**: Check that all 4 hinges are fully engaged by pulling out on the door before removing hands from door.

- 8. Door Operation:
  - a. Left Hinging: Pull right door latch upward and pull door open.
  - b. Right Hinging: Pull left door latch upward and pull door open.
  - c. To Close Door: Simply push door closed, the hinges will automatically engage.
  - d. To Remove Door: With hands on each side of door, pull both door latches simultaneously and lift door from frame.
