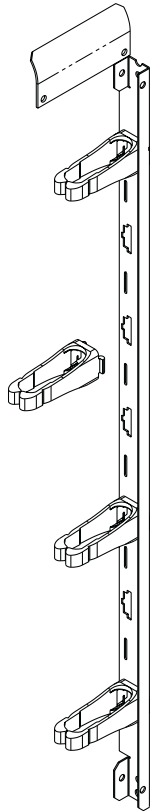


# Frequently Asked Questions

## SLIMFRAME C-SERIES CABINET CABLE MANAGER

**Q. When should the Wall-Rack Cable Management Rings be used?**

A. The Wall-Rack Cable Management Rings should be used to complement all installations of CPI's Standard Swing Gate Wall Rack and Fixed Wall-Mount Equipment Rack. Wall racks are almost exclusively used to support cabling, patch panels and network switches that interconnect small user groups. The rings may be used to create a cable pathway along the wall rack's "legs" for cables entering or exiting the rack and for vertical cable management along the front, side or rear of the rack's equipment mounting channels.

**Q. When do I use the SlimFrame C-Series Cable Manager?**

A. When you have a need for cable management in a cabinet(SlimFrame C-Series) that must fit on a 24" floor tile.

**Q. How many vertical cable managers can I use in 24", 30" and 36" deep SlimFrames?**

A. Three, four, and four respectively per each side if attached in the space between the side panel and horizontal slide. In addition, you can add two vertical cable managers per side by utilizing the extra rail bolts on the inside edge of the horizontal slides.

**Q. What is the useable size of the cable rings?**

A. 1" x 3" = 3 square inches

**Q. How many .25" patch cables with 40% fill factor will fit into the cable manager?**

A. 24 cables = one 24 port patch

**Q. What are my options if my cable management requirements exceed the SlimFrame C-Series Cabinet Cable Manager?**

A. The standard MegaFrame® Vertical Cabling Ring Section is available when buying two or more SlimFrame cabinets together. (The MegaFrame Vertical Cabling Ring Section cannot be used if installing a side panel.)

**Q. What hardware do I need to install the cable manager?**

A. The hardware kit is included with each cable manager ordered. The kit contains ¼ -20 x ½ bolts and ¼ flat washers for attaching the cable rings to the outside edge of the horizontal slides, and 5/16 serrated flange nuts for attaching the cable rings to the inside edge of the horizontal slides.

**Q. Does the cable manager infringe on the useable depth of the cabinet?**

A. The versatile cable manager is designed to mount in three different orientations. The preferred orientation (between the side panel and horizontal slide) does not interfere with the useable depth of the cabinet.
