#3 Phillips screwdriver



Installation

Note: Accessory panels accommodate Fiber Segregation and Cable Lashing Bar Kits. Refer to the Fiber Segregation Kit and Cable Lashing Bar Kit installation instruction sheets for recommended Mid-section spacing when using accessories.

- 1. Decide where you would like to install the Midsection. Note: Mid may not span rack mount bolts in center position (Figure 1).
- 2. The Mid may be mounted anywhere in the manager that has a top and bottom pair of open mounting slots (Figure 2).
- 3. The Mid may be mounted in a front, middle, or rear mounting setback position to allow for a custom

division of cable management space. It is recommended to install the Mid-sections in line with the same setback position of any Mids already mounted in the manager in order to prevent interference with accessories.

- 4. Using both hands, grasp each end of the Mid-section and telescope the sections together so that the panel is narrow enough to fit into the cable manager.
- Telescope the sides of the panel outward until the mounting tabs pass through the desired mounting slots (Figure 3).
- Keeping the Mid's sides fully extended, push the Mid-section downward until all four mounting tabs engage with the sides of the cable manager.
- 7. Using the #3 Phillips screw driver, slide the left locking screw to the outside edge of its slot and tighten (Figure 2).
- 8. Repeat for the right locking screw.
- 9. Apply moderate upward pressure on the mid to ensure it is properly locked in place.

Note: If the side panel catch is difficult to engage, try loosening the screw 5 turns back from finger tight to allow extra compliance.
